

The Warrick SWCD 2024 Poster Contest theme this year is: "MAY THE FOREST BE WITH YOU, ALWAYS"

Contest Rules:

- The 2024 theme "MAY THE FOREST BE WITH YOU, ALWAYS" must be included on the front of each poster to be eligible for the state poster contest.
- All poster entries should be sent to Warrick County Soil and Water Conservation District: 1124 S 8th Street, Boonville, Indiana 47601.
- Any media may be used, including paint, crayon, colored pencil, charcoal, stickers, paper, or other materials.
- All posters must be created by an individual student and must be an original creation.
- Posters are judged in two-grade divisions (K-1; 2-3; 4-6; 7-9; 10-12)
- The registration form must be completed and signed by a parent or guardian and taped to the back of the poster.
- Deadline is April 5, 2024.

Poster Evaluation:

The poster will be reviewed based on the following criteria:

- Conservation Message (50 percent) poster has to use correct theme.
- Visual effectiveness (30 percent)
- Originality (10 percent)
- Universal appeal (10 percent)

Prizes:

Local monetary awards and recognition will be given to 1st, 2nd and 3rd places in each division. State winners will be eligible for NACD's National Poster Contest and monetary prizes.
